7-ELEMENT OBSTACLE COURSE

This instruction manual should be used in conjunction with Inflatable 2000 Operations Manual. Specific rules that apply to the 7-Element are details in this manual. Always read the "Safety Rules" label attached to the inflatable game prior to operation. This label will specify any instructions relevant to the game, to ensure safe operation

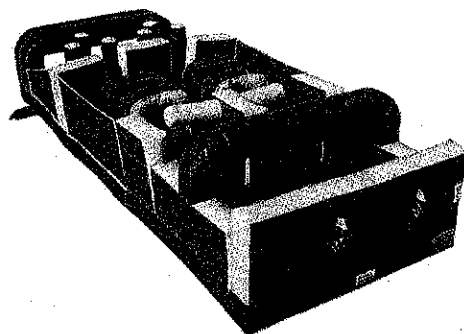

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once all of the procedures outlined in the General Operations Manual have been implemented, the following procedures for the 7-Element Obstacle Course are to be followed:

1. *Be sure that the areas that you will be setting your inflatable up are free of all debris, including any rocks or sharp objects.*
2. *Lay out a tarp*
3. *Unroll the inflatable and attach (1) 1.5 HP blower to one tube.*
4. *Tie off unused tube to ensure no air leakage.*
5. *The 7-Element Obstacle Course is to be anchored by at least (4) **anchor points** (see illustration). 12" stakes on soft ground or 250lb in sandbag weight on hard ground (or indoor location) are appropriate anchor tools.*
6. ***The 7-Element Obstacle Course should not be operated in wind speed in excess of 15 MPH. Deflate immediately if wind gusts develop.***
7. *Do not secure the inflatable to a vehicle (or any object) that could be inadvertently moved while the 7-Element Obstacle Course is in operation.*
8. *You are now ready to inflate the unit.*
 - ***The trained operator(s) should now perform an inspection of the attraction as per Inflatable 2000' recommendation found in the General Operations Manual.***

The trained operator(s) should be present at all times. Under no circumstances should the 7-Element Obstacle Course (or any inflatable) be left unattended. During operation of the 7-Element Obstacle Course, the trained operator(s) can stand at the entrance and exit.

RULES OF PLAY

- ~NO GLASSES ~ NO SHOES ~ NO HATS~**
- ~NO SHARP ONJECTS ~ NO FLIPS~**
- ~NO FOOD, CHEWING GUM OR DRINK~**
- ~NO JUMPING ~ NO CLIMBING ON WALLS~**
- ~NO FIGHTING OR ROUGH PLAY**
- ~PERSONS WITH NECK, BACK, KNEE, BONE,
JOINT INJURIES, RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS OR
WHO MAY BE PREGNANT SHOULD NOT

- If the attraction begins to deflate due to a power loss or otherwise, the total deflation time on the 7-Element Obstacle Course is 7 minutes. Should such an event occur, the trained operators should advise the participants on an orderly exit and not allow any new participants to enter the attraction until the attraction inflates properly.*

NOW WE ARE READY TO PLAY THE GAME!

The object of the game is to see which team is the fastest through the 7-Element Obstacle Course. When the trained operator says go, (2) players on opposite teams enter the inflatable and race each other through tubes, walls and barriers to see who gets to the finish point first. As soon as the first (2) opponents are half way through, the trained operator sends the next (2) opponents through and so on. The second trained operator is at the exit making sure that all players have exited the game safely. If either of the trained operators find that players are milling around inside the unit and not exiting, stop the game immediately for the opponents to exit. Once the players have exited, you are free to resume playing.

Player's heights should be a minimum of 44" to 80" maximum.

The trained operator(s) should be present at all times. Under no circumstances, should the 7-Element Obstacle Course (or any inflatable) be left unattended.

Special care: Your inflatable is made of a 15 oz PVC coated vinyl that can be washed (while inflated) with water and a mild degreaser. Allow unit to dry completely before packing it up so mildew doesn't occur. Harsh cleaners or bleach should not be used as they will damage the fabric over time.
