Setting Up the Wizzer

- Wizzers can be setup on surfaces that have been compacted such as blacktop, concrete, established lawns, etc.
- Disconnect trailer from towing vehicle.
- Remove gates from the Wizzer and set them up in a complete circle around the ride, with the Wizzer in the center of the circle.
- You will need shims (pieces of plywood or something similar) beneath the leg of the drop jacks.
- Pull pin and extend jacks out so the holes in the trailer and jack arms align. The jacks should be used to make the Wizzer completely level. Level the trailer from front to back and side-to-side. If needed, add shims under the jacks to level the Wizzer on uneven surfaces. Reinsert pins in holes of jacks.

Operating Rules for Wizzer

- Be sure that the operator is instructed regarding operation of the unit before operation begins.
- The operator should perform the **pre-operation inspection check list daily BEFORE** accepting passengers as well as perform the inspections during daily operation break time. If the unit is transported to multiple sites on a single day, the operator should perform the pre-operation check list **BEFORE** accepting passengers at each new site.
- Do NOT operate this ride in the rain, snow or lightning storms. Do NOT let anyone onto the ride until a half hour of time has elapsed since the last clap of thunder that you hear. Wait ½ hour after the last clap of thunder even if the sky appears clear.
- Do NOT operate the unit while under the influence of alcohol or drugs or when very tired. Do NOT operate this unit if you are taking drugs or other medication(s) which can cause drowsiness or affect your ability to operate the unit.
- Minimum height requirement is 42". Maximum weight per seat is 200 pounds. Maximum weight per car is 400 pounds. Balance weight between the two sides. Passengers must fit inside the restraint system. Buckle seat belts.
- Maximum ride length is 3 minutes.

In Case of Injury

- If an injury occurs that requires more than basic first aid:
 - 1 Do not move the injured person. Immediately seek medical assistance and call for an ambulance.
 - 2 Do not allow any additional participants onto the attraction.
 - 3 Do not move the attraction. Immediately call an Interactive Playgrounds' representative who will contact the appropriate N.C. amusement safety officials who will investigate the accident and perform a site inspection within 24 hours.
 - 4 Fill out an Incident Report for Interactive Playgrounds Inc.
