

## Candy House Combo Wet/Dry-V-SL Play Instruction

The Candy House Combo Wet/Dry-V-SL is used as a bounce and slide combo ride:

1. For normal operations, there shall be an operator at the entrance controlling access to the ride and assisting riders off. The operator shall also verbally control riders on the slide from that position.
2. When entering the ride, there is bounce area to use and a climb/slide on the right side.
3. Only one rider is allowed on a slide at a time. The operator shall strictly control this and not allow a rider to go down until the landing area is clear. Double riding is strictly forbidden!
4. Riders on the slide shall only ride feet first. They shall be instructed to sit down first before moving down the slide. Riding head-first is prohibited. On no account allow any rider to jump or dive on to the slide!
5. Make sure the landing pad is cleared quickly and that riders do not use this area as a bouncer.
6. Do not allow anyone to jump on the entrance step.
7. Do not climb the walls or nettings.
8. Do not allow a new set of riders to enter the ride until the previous group has exited. No more than 15 at a time on this ride. If there are bigger riders using the ride, you may only allow 10 riders at a time. Use common sense to keep the ride operating as a safe environment for the riders.
9. The following evacuation instructions should be followed in case of power failure: 9.1 Stop riders from entering the ride, including parents 9.2 riders in the bounce area shall be told to leave through the entrance in an orderly manner. There is no need to rush, there is plenty of time and rushing may intimidate smaller and more timid riders. 9.3 Riders shall be told to leave back down the rock climb if they are on the lower part, or slide down if they are up top. There is plenty of time so riders should not be rushed, especially on the slide. 9.4 Apply the normal slide rule of one rider on each slide at any time. 9.5 It takes close to two minutes before the ride starts to sag noticeably, and even then a rider may safely slide down and exit. Evacuation of this ride should take no more than 30-45 seconds. 9.6 Do not allow anyone to enter the ride until it is properly re-inflated and the power supply is stabilized.

### Important Information:

1. Waiting riders should stand at least 3ft (1m) from the entrance of the ride. 2. Running to enter the ride is not permitted. 3. Enter the ride head first is only allowed from a standing position. 4. One rider per ride entry location is allowed to enter the ride at a time. 5. Do not allow the riders to stand up and run off the ride. 6. Do not allow somersaults or back flips anywhere on the ride. 7. Do not wear shoes on the ride. Remove any hard or sharp objects such as pens, buckles, jewelry, hair clips, etc. Glasses are best removed also. 8. No gum or wearing face paint allowed. 9. Do not allow riders to deliberately collide with one another. 10. At least one adult operator shall be on duty at all times the ride is being used. 11. Please refer to the safety label on the ride for the minimum Height and Max weight requirements. 12. Make sure there always be same age group or height group play the ride at one time, mix up group is dangerous. 13. If the ride becomes wet, dry the wet area before continuing use. 14. If the power fails, assist the riders off the ride immediately and do not allow them to re-enter until power is restored and the ride is fully inflated again.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If the fan is restarted following power failure, or accidental switching off, be sure to verify that the fan is running correctly. If the flapper valve does not close properly, or is missing, the deflation of the ride may cause the fan to spin in the opposite direction when restarted. If this happens, the blower will not inflate the ride properly.
